SUMMARY: HB 1889 PN 2367 would permit the use of electronic delivery tickets for light fuel oil deliveries upon direct customer consent. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Title 3 (Agriculture) Section 4180 (Meter Required) to provide for electronic receipts modernization for meters equipped with the capability of issuing an electronic receipt, ticket or other recorded representation. A domestic consumer may be given the option to receive a meter-printed delivery ticket electronically in lieu of or in addition to a printed delivery ticket.

The seller or deliverer may not impose a separate fee for consumers to accept a delivery ticket by any method and an electronic delivery ticket may only be provided if agreed to by the consumer and if the technology is available.

FISCAL IMPACT: The enactment of this legislation would have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The bill simply provides the seller or deliverer of light fuel oil to issue an electronic delivery ticket upon the receipt of customer consent.
