SUMMARY:

Clarifies and updates language under the National Human Trafficking Resource Center Hotline Notification Act (Act 197 of 2012), to ensure that victims of human trafficking have access to services.

ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 45 Printer's Number 927 is a technical update to the National Human Trafficking Resource Center Hotline Notification Act (Act 197 of 2012). The legislation updates definitions related to human trafficking in Section 9 (Victim services) of the act, ensuring that eligibility of victims of human trafficking to receive services.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds. According to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD), which provides for the victim services, it is unlikely that any victims have been denied services. If this legislation does result in additional victims of human trafficking requesting services, the services provided by the act are provided only to the extent that federal or state funds are available.
