SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 84, Printer's Number 10, repeals the provision in the Public School Code prohibiting professional employees from wearing religious garb or insignia in the performance of their duties.

ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 84, Printer's Number 10, amends Article XI – Professional Employees – of the Public School Code by repealing provisions prohibiting and providing a punishment for professional employees wearing religious garb or insignia in the performance of their duties.

This bill takes effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 84 will have no adverse fiscal impact on commonwealth funds.
