SUMMARY:

Amends Title 51 to make civilians and members of the military of friendly foreign nations eligible to receive certain Pennsylvania military awards and decorations.

ANALYSIS:

Amends Section 3701 of Title 51 to allow foreign civilians and members of the military from friendly foreign nations eligible to receive the Pennsylvania Distinguished Service Medal and the Pennsylvania Meritorious Service Medal. These awards may currently be awarded to civilians, veterans, and members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, Pennsylvania Guard, or armed forces or reserves of the United States.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds. Any additional costs resulting from this change will be absorbed by the current annual budget for provision of awards and decorations within the Department of Military and Veteran Affairs.
