SUMMARY:

Senate bill 224 amends the Pennsylvania Election Code regarding dates for the General Primary for 2024.

ANALYSIS:

This bill makes several changes to the election code.

First, it sets the General primary for 2024 to be held on April 16, 2024.

Second, for 2024, it instructs school districts to use the fourth Tuesday of April 2024 instead of the date of the General Primary for purposes of the school district budget timeline set forth in the Taxpayer Relief Act.

Third, for the 2023-24 school year, it instructs school districts to use the fourth Tuesday of April instead of the date of the primary election for determining compliance with Title 53, Section 8041 related to the timing of a referendum by a local government unit.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
