SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 226, Printer's Number 195 amends the Fire and Panic Act to change a compliance date for smoke alarm and fire extinguisher standards for family child-care homes that were enacted by the General Assembly in 2022.

ANALYSIS:

The bill provides family child-care homes licensed by the Department of Human Services as of September 6, 2022 until September 6, 2023 to comply with the provisions of the act.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The change in the date will have no fiscal impact to the commonwealth.
