#### SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 262 Printer's Number 833 amends Act 24 of 2018, known as the Maternal Mortality Review Act, to require the Maternal Mortality Review Committee to publish severe maternal morbidity data.

#### ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 262 amends Act 24 of 2018, known as the Maternal Mortality Review Act, which established the Maternal Mortality Review Committee and provides for the Committee's powers and duties.

SB262 requires the Committee, in addition to their other duties, to annually publish severe maternal morbidity data. This data must be included in the annual report issued by the Committee.

This legislation will take effect in 90 days.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact. The Department of Health may have a nominal cost to review and compile the severe maternal morbidity data. In addition, there may be a nominal cost to prepare the required report on an annual basis. However, any nominal increase in costs can be absorbed by the department's current appropriations.
