**SUMMARY:** SB 979 PN 1206 requires the posting of information on dangerous transmissible diseases. This legislation will take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends Title 3 (Agriculture) by adding Section 2336 (relating to posting a notice with information on dangerous transmissible diseases) to give the Department of Agriculture the authority to require a dealer, agent, or a person that offers a domestic animal, commercial feed, or pet food for sale to the public to post a notice on the premises with information on dangerous transmissible disease.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** The fiscal impact from enactment of this legislation would be de minimis on Commonwealth funds, as the legislation simply provides for the posting of information.
