DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 1421 appropriates \$35,113,000 from the Professional Licensure Augmentation Account to the Department of State for the operation of the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs and the State Board of Auctioneer Examiners for FY 2009-10.

The bill also appropriates the following amounts from the restricted receipt accounts and the State Athletic Commission Augmentation
