DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 1422 appropriates \$72,218,000 from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry for the administration of the Workers' Compensation Act and the Pennsylvania Occupational Disease Act for Fiscal Year 2009-10.

The bill also appropriates \$190,000 from a restricted account within the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Office of Small Business Advocate for its operation in FY 2009-10.
