DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 87 amends the act of December 15, 1982 (P.L. 1266, No. 287), to provide that a community college, state-related or state-owned institution of higher learning may charge resident tuition rates to any active military personnel, their spouses or dependents who are taking college courses or receiving other educational services through the Internet or other electronic means.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 87 will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
