DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 88 amends Section 1302 (Residence and Right to Free School Privileges) of the Public School Code to allow a child who resides outside of the Commonwealth, as a result of one or both parents being called to active military duty, to remain a resident of the school district that was the child's resident school district prior to the parents call to active military duty, provided the parent maintains the residence.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The adoption of Senate Bill 88 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
