DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 301 changes the eligibility requirements for reduced fees for fishing licenses from 180 days of active deployment to 60 days within the previous 24 month period for the members of the Pennsylvania National Guard, Air National Guard, or Reservists. The fee is reduced from the current license fee of \$21 to \$1.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Fish Commission estimates that about 25 – 50 additional persons may be eligible for and take advantage of the reduced fee. The current fishing license fee is \$21. Reducing the fee for these persons to \$1 would result in lost revenue of \$20/person. Therefore, the reduced license fee could result in decreased revenue to the Fish Fund of \$500 to \$1,000.
