DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1039 as amended provides a non-preferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for veterinary activities in the amount of \$34,419,000 for fiscal year 2009-10.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect immediately.

Non-preferred appropriations require an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the House of Representatives and the Senate.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 1039 will cost the Commonwealth \$34,419,000 in fiscal year 2009-10.
