DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bills 1093 through 1108 are the non-preferred appropriation bills for fiscal year 2009- 10^{1} . They provide funding to various educational and health-related institutions not under the direct control of the Commonwealth.

Non-preferred appropriations require an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the House and Senate.

The total amount appropriated by these bills for fiscal year 2009-10 is \$5,860,000. All appropriations received a significant decrease from the preceding fiscal year.

A worksheet listing each non-preferred appropriation bill on today's agenda is attached.
