DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 1729 provides for the Commonwealth's nonpreferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for fiscal year 2011-2012.

The bill specifies \$27,889,000 shall be provided for Veterinary Activities and \$248,000 for the Center for Infectious Disease and payments to the university are to be made on a quarterly basis.

The funding level represents a 6.2 percent reduction in funds compared to the current year.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1729 will cost the Commonwealth \$28,137,000 in fiscal year 2011-2012.
