**DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

Senate Bill 717 establishes a free-standing act designating the Piper J-3 Cub as the official state airplane of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect immediately.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The enactment of Senate Bill 717 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth Funds. Administrative responsibilities related to acknowledging the designation of the Piper J-3 Cub as Pennsylvania's official airplane will be minor and can be accomplished within the existing operating budgets of the Historical & Museum Commission and the Department of General Services.
