**DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

Senate Bill 725 amends The Borough Code (Act 581 of 1965) to remove references to the office of elected assessor from the code.

The Act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.

Senate Bill 725 has no fiscal impact on local funds because the office of local elected assessor was abolished by Act 93 of 2010 (Consolidated County Assessment Law) under Title 53 PaC.S. § 8832(d). Essentially, Senate Bill 725 is legislation needed to "clean up" The Borough Code.
