DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1126 provides for the Commonwealth's nonpreferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for fiscal year 2011-2012.

The bill specifies \$28,752,000 shall be provided for Veterinary Activities and \$248,000 for the Center for Infectious Disease and payments to the university are to be made on a quarterly basis.

The funding level is the same as proposed by the Governor and represents a 3.3 percent reduction in funds compared to the current year.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 1126 will cost the Commonwealth \$29,000,000 in fiscal year 2011-2012.
