DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 1466 is the 2012 General Appropriations Act which provides for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2012 to June 30 2013. General Fund and federal augmenting appropriations total \$26,756,245,000¹ and \$19,099,308,000 respectively.

The bill also makes state and federal appropriations for a variety of special funds which are summarized in the following chart:

SENATE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE FISCAL NOTE

Part XIX of the bill makes state and federal supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2011-12. Net state and federal supplemental appropriations for the General Fund are \$1,000,000 and \$80,338,000 respectively. In addition, net supplemental appropriations for special funds include \$31,000,000 for the Motor License Fund, \$1,395,000 for the Home Improvement Account and \$50,000 for the Cigarette Fire Safety and Firefighter Protection Act Enforcement Fund.

All appropriations contained in this legislation are at the amounts recommended by the Governor.
