**DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

The Act takes effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Senate Bill 1474 appropriates \$37,072,000 from the Professional Licensure Augmentation Account to the Department of State for the operation of the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs and the State Board of Auctioneer Examiners for FY 2012-13.

The bill also appropriates the following amounts from restricted receipt accounts and the State Athletic Commission Augmentation Account for the operation of the various licensure boards and the State Athletic Commission for their operations during FY 2012-13.

\$6,948,000 – State Board of Medicine  
\$1,006,000 – State Board of Osteopathic Medicine  
\$ 198,000 – State Board of Podiatry  
\$ 509,000 – State Athletic Commission
