### **DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

Senate Bill 1478 appropriates \$75,896,000 from the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Department of Labor and Industry for the administration of the Workers' Compensation Act and the Occupational Disease Act, for fiscal year 2012-2013 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of fiscal year 2011-2012.

The bill also appropriates \$194,000 from a restricted revenue account within the Workmen's Compensation Administration Fund to the Office of the Small Business Advocate in the Department of Community and Economic Development for the operation of that office for fiscal year 2012-2013.

The Act takes effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later.
