DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 1460 amends §7313 (relating to educational leave of absence) of Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for educational leave of absence and grade transcripts.

Specifically, this legislation requires an educational institution to give any member of the Pennsylvania National Guard or other reserve component of the armed forces of the United States, or the member's spouse, an "M" or "Military" on their grade transcript for all classes they are unable to complete due to a military leave of absence.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation would have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds or funds of any educational institution as they would simply be replacing a "W" or "Withdrawn" with an "M" or "Military."
