DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 114 amends the Breach of Personal Information Notification Act to further provide for notice related to the breach of security of personal information as follows:

- Requires a state agency to notify the subjects of a breach within seven days following discovery and the Attorney General within three business days.
- Requires a state agency under the Governor's jurisdiction to notify the Office of Administration of a breach within three business days.
- Requires a county, school district or local municipality to notify subjects of a breach within seven days following discovery and the district attorney in the county where the breach occurred within three business days.

At present, the law requires that a notice is to be given to the subjects of a breach without reasonable delay.

The legislation shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of Senate Bill 114 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
