DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 492 amends the Liquid Fuels Tax Municipal Allocation Law (1955 P.L. 1944, No. 655) by changing the payment date for liquid fuel tax funds appropriated to municipalities.

Specifically, this legislation would require the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation to distribute the liquid fuel tax funds to individual municipalities on the first day of March each year. Current law provides for these funds to be distributed on the first day of April each year.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This legislation simply changes the date that municipalities will receive liquid fuel tax distributions from the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation.

Therefore, the enactment of this legislation would have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
