DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 729 provides for the Commonwealth's nonpreferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for fiscal year 2013-2014.

The bill specifies \$28,000,000 shall be provided for Veterinary Activities and \$261,000 for the Center for Infectious Disease and payments to the university are to be made on a quarterly basis.

The legislation provides for an increase of \$124,000, or 0.4% over the current year.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect July 1, 2013, or immediately, whichever is later.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 729 will cost the Commonwealth \$28,261,000 in fiscal year 2013-2014.
