DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 192 amends Section 206 (Powers and Duties of the Director) of the Civil Service Act to require the Director of the Civil Service Commission to advertise veterans' preference on the commission's publically accessible Internet website and in all announcements, advertisements and examination materials, that veteran's preference is the law of the Commonwealth and that to determine standing on all certified eligibility lists, an additional 10 points will be applied to a final examination score obtained by a veteran, and the same preferential rating given to veterans shall be extended to include spouses, consistent with current law, if the veteran is deceased or disabled.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of House Bill 192 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The Civil Service Commission already advertises veterans' preference in a prominent manner on its Internet website and other materials and can make any minor changes required by the act within its current operating budget.
