DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

Senate Bill 285 amends §1721 of Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes further providing for the Veterans’ Trust Fund.

Specifically, §1721 (a)(2) is amended to include amounts payable to the Fund from the sales of “Honoring our veterans” special motorcycle registration license plates (75 Pa.C.S. §1361 (relating to special motorcycle plates for veterans) as a source of revenue for the Veterans’ Trust Fund.

Senate Bill 284, Printer’s Number 783 amends §1361 of Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to establish the “Honoring our veterans” special motorcycle registration license plate. That legislation further provides for \$15 of the \$35 additional fee for the special motorcycle registration license plate to be deposited into the Veterans’ Trust Fund. This legislation statutorily authorizes those deposits.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
