**DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

Senate Bill 812 appropriates \$43,946,000 from the Professional Licensure Augmentation Account within the General Fund to the Department of State for the operation of the Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs, including the State Board of Auctioneers, for fiscal year 2015-16.

The bill also appropriates the following amounts from the restricted receipt accounts and the State Athletic Commission Augmentation Account for the operation of the various licensure boards and the State Athletic Commission for their operations in fiscal year 2015-2016.

- \$8,184,000 – State Board of Medicine
- \$1,523,000 – State Board of Osteopathic Medicine
- \$ 245,000 – State Board of Podiatry
- \$ 560,000 – State Athletic Commission

The act takes effect July 1, 2015, or immediately, whichever is later.
