**DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

House Bill 218, printer's number 1236, is the General Appropriation Act of 2017, which provides for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. General Fund and federal augmenting appropriations total \$31,380,465,000 and \$26,601,985,000, respectively.

The bill also makes state and federal appropriations for a variety of special funds which are summarized in the following chart:
