**DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL**

Senate Bill 144 amends the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act to allow for the use of alternative on-lot sewage systems for planning purposes throughout the Commonwealth.

When proposing a plan supplement or plan revision for a new land development, the applicant may submit and the Department of Environmental Protection is required to accept, for the purpose of satisfying general site suitability requirements, any conventional or alternate on-lot system permissible by a sewage enforcement officer.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

SB 144 will have no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
