DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 299 amends the Pennsylvania Election Code to change the process by which an incumbent magisterial district judge gets on the primary ballot for reelection.

Incumbent magisterial district judges would file a certificate of nomination for reelection, as opposed to the current nomination petition and at least 100 signatures. The nomination petition and signature requirement will remain for a candidate's primary election if the candidate does not already hold office.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to Commonwealth funds.
