DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 803 amends the Second Class Township Code to allow townships of the second class to purchase used equipment, vehicles, and other personal property from volunteer emergency service organizations without competitive bidding.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There will be no fiscal impact to Commonwealth funds.

Currently, there are competitive bidding exemptions provided for transactions between local governments, the Commonwealth and federal government to allow for contracts where the public interest may not be reflected by private market values for goods and services. It can be anticipated that Second Class townships would recognize savings from lower market value prices agreed to between townships and these quasi-governmental organizations. It is also anticipated that townships will save the advertising and administrative costs associated with preparing a notice for requests for bids. The average cost to publish in a medium size paper in the Legal Notice section for a full page is about \$6,800, half-page \$3,400 and quarter-page \$1,700.
