**DESCRIPTION**

Senate Bill 1136 amends Section 778 (School Police Officers) of the School Code to provide that a school located in a municipality with no municipal police department may enter into a cooperative police service agreement with a municipality providing part-time police coverage that is located in an adjacent municipality.

The legislation is scheduled to take effect in 60 days.

Currently, the law provides that a school located in a municipality with no municipal police department may enter a cooperative police service agreement with a municipality providing full-time police coverage that is located in an adjacent municipality.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

The enactment of Senate Bill 1136 will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Schools and municipalities choosing to enter into cooperative police service agreements will bear the costs associated with the agreements.
