**DESCRIPTION**

House Bill 512 amends Title 11 (Cities) to change the process by which a city may enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement.

This legislation will remove the requirement that a city must pass an ordinance to enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

House Bill 512 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Cities choosing to enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement may see a reduction in legal and advertising costs normally associate with the passage of an ordinance, which will no longer be required.
