### DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF BILL

House Bill 790, printer's number 2215 is the General Appropriation Act of 2019, which provides for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020. General Fund and federal augmenting appropriations total \$33,355,801,000 and \$27,719,878,000, respectively.

The bill also makes state and federal appropriations for a variety of special funds which are summarized in the following chart:
