**DESCRIPTION**

House Bill 1457 amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 concerning mastectomy and breast cancer reconstruction.

The bill amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 to provide clarity regarding insurance coverage for custom-fabricated breast prostheses post mastectomy surgery by adding "custom artificial devices" to the definition of "prosthetic device."

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

House Bill 1457 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds because the Commonwealth's Medicaid program already covers custom prostheses after mastectomy surgery.
