DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 316 amends the Second Class Township Code to provide for reimbursement for newly elected township supervisors.

This legislation would allow for a newly elected supervisor, prior to officially taking office, to attend conferences, institutes, schools and conventions dealing with the duties and functions of elected or appointed officers to receive reimbursement for the costs of attending.

The act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 316 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The Second Class Township code currently provides for the reimbursement for supervisors to attend educational events dealing with the duties and functions of their position if directed by the board of supervisors. Second class townships may incur additional costs if they choose to direct newly elected supervisors to attend such events before they have officially taken office.
