DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 698 amends the Medical Practice Act of 1985 to allow for the use of a delegate for the submission of forms to the board.

This legislation allows for a delegate of the primary supervising physician and the physician assistant to submit to the board the written agreement between the physician and the assisting physician assistant.

The bill also provides definitions for 'primary supervising physician' and 'substitute supervising physician'.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There is no fiscal impact to Commonwealth funds. The Department of State may need to revise regulations as a result of this legislation. Any costs of promulgating new regulations can be accommodated within the department's current funding levels.
