**DESCRIPTION**

Senate Bill 1060 provides for the Commonwealth's non-preferred appropriation to the Pennsylvania State University for Fiscal Year 2020-21.

The legislation specifies \$242,096,000 shall be provided for General Support and \$26,736,000 for Penn College of Technology, and payments to the university are made on a monthly basis.

Senate Bill 1060 also authorizes the appropriation of moneys contained within the Agricultural College Land Scrip Fund restricted receipt account for Agricultural Research and Extension Services. Funds provided for in this account are appropriated as part of the General Appropriations Act.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2020, or immediately, whichever is later.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Senate Bill 1060 will cost the Commonwealth a total of \$268,832,000 in Fiscal Year 2020-21. That preliminary funding amount is level with last year's budget and is identical to the Governor's proposed level. The appropriation will be revised when a final funding amount for Fiscal Year 2020-21 is determined.
