**DESCRIPTION**

Senate Bill 1296 amends the County Code providing for requirements for the purchase of property.

This bill prohibits commissioners in a county of the fourth class from purchasing property in a city of the third class which would remove the property from the tax rolls of the city, unless the city and school district have passed resolutions approving the purchase.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Senate Bill 1296 will have no fiscal impact on the Commonwealth.

There are eight cities of the third class that are located in a county of the 4<sup>th</sup> class:

- Aliquippa (Beaver)
- Beaver Falls (Beaver)
- Butler (Butler)
- Johnstown (Cambria)
- Monongahela (Washington)
- Pottsville (Schuylkill)
- Uniontown (Fayette)
- Washington (Washington)
