**DESCRIPTION**

House Bill 220 amends the Administrative Code in the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs (DDAP) regarding admission to treatment and rehabilitative facilities.

The bill requires the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs to establish standards that the state agency must apply when approving public and private drug and alcohol treatment and rehabilitative facilities.

The bill mandates that the standards prohibit facilities from denying treatment to an individual based solely on a negative result on a drug test.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

House Bill 220 will have no fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs does not require a positive drug test for an individual to receive treatment; therefore, no additional services are anticipated from enactment of this legislation.
