DESCRIPTION

House Bill 1774 amends the Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act to add additional authorized users and extend the expiration date of the act.

The bill adds Commonwealth personnel and contracted staff who are responsible for Catastrophic Loss Benefits Continuation Fund and Workers' Compensation Security Fund programs, as well as Department of Labor and Industry personnel engaged in the administration and regulation of medical fee review disputes and utilization review of medical treatment under the Workers' Compensation Act, to the list of authorized users of the prescription monitoring system.

In addition, the bill extends the expiration of the ABC-MAP Act from June 30, 2022 to December 31, 2028

This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1774 will have no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth. The Commonwealth's Prescription Drug Monitoring Program created under Achieving Better Care by Monitoring All Prescriptions Program (ABC-MAP) Act is already in existence and is currently funded at \$2.989 million in General Funds for Fiscal Year 2021-22.
