DESCRIPTION

House Bill 2214 amends Title 67 (Public Welfare) to render certain indemnification clauses unenforceable in government contracts between county children and youth agencies and entities that provide children and youth services.

The bill adds section 8102 (Indemnification agreements) to provide that any provision in a contract between a municipal government entity and entities that provide children and youth services in which a municipal government entity is indemnified from damages, claims, losses or expenses arising from bodily injury, mental anguish or property damages caused by the municipal government entity's negligence is unenforceable.

This section applies to service provider contracts entered into on or after the effective date of the bill.

This act shall take effect in 90 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

According to the Department of Human Services, House Bill 2214 will have no fiscal impact to the Commonwealth.
