**DESCRIPTION**

Senate Bill 486 amends the Workforce Development Act to provide preference to recently discharged members of the armed forces and their spouses for job training programs.

This bill provides for members of the Pennsylvania National Guard or a reserve component of the United State Armed Forces and their spouses, for one year after discharge from active duty, to receive preference for placement in any program under the Workforce Development Act.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Senate Bill 486 will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. This legislation does not expand the population of eligible participants in programs funded through the Workforce Development Act. Rather, it only prioritizes certain members of the eligible population.
