**DESCRIPTION**

Senate Bill 905 amends Section 6.1 of Act 274 of 1978, known as the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency Law, requiring the County Adult Probation and Parole Advisory Committee (committee) to make recommendations and adopt standards that should be weighed by probation and parole personnel when making scheduling decisions.

These recommendations and standards shall include the circumstances under which an offender’s schedule, including consideration of the offender’s work schedule and any scheduled essential medical care, should be weighed when making scheduling decisions.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

According to the Pennsylvania Commission on Crime and Delinquency (PCCD), enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.

The committee has already added language contained within Senate Bill 905 to the county adult probation and parole standards, which the PCCD ratified on December 8, 2021.
