DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 1019 amends the Administrative Code in COVID-19 regulatory flexibility authority to expand Act 73 of 2021, formerly House Bill 1861.

The bill requires that no later than May 31, 2022, each authority shall issue a permanent suspension report identifying any regulatory statute, rule or regulation that was temporarily suspended pursuant to the declaration that the authority believes should be considered for a permanent suspension.

The report shall include all of the following:

- The citation to the regulatory statute, rule or regulation that has been identified by the authority;
- The date in which the regulatory statute, rule or regulation was originally suspended;
- Whether the suspension was extended until September 30, 2021;
- Whether the suspension was extended to March 31, 2022;
- Whether the suspension has been terminated and, if so, the date of termination;
- Whether the suspension was terminated by the authority or operation of law; and
- Analysis relating to the purpose for permanently suspending the regulatory statute, rule or regulation.

This act shall take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Senate Bill 1019 has no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The final report provisions of Senate Bill 1019 can be accomplished within existing staffing and funding levels provided to executive agencies.
