DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 1105 provides for the Commonwealth's non-preferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for Fiscal Year 2022-23.

The legislation specifies \$31,660,000 shall be provided for Veterinary Activities and \$1,893,000 for the Center for Infectious Diseases, and payments are to be made on a quarterly basis.

This act shall take effect July 1, 2022, or immediately, whichever is later.

FISCAL IMPACT

Senate Bill 1105 will cost the Commonwealth a total of \$33,553,000 in Fiscal Year 2022-23. The funding level represents an increase of \$1,598,000, or 5%, when considering the current (2021-22) fiscal year's budget.
