DESCRIPTION

Senate Bill 1123 Amends Title 75 (Vehicles) to allow tow truck operators to use rear-facing blue lights while responding to a disabled vehicle.

This legislation amends § 4572 (relating to visual signals on authorized vehicles) to provide that a tow truck may be equipped with one or more flashing or revolving blue lights in addition to the use of yellow lights under the following conditions:

- The blue lights may only be in the rear of the vehicle;
- The tow truck is stationary on the side of the road or highway; and
- The tow truck operator must be responding to a disabled vehicle.

The bill prohibits the use of the flashing or revolving blue lights on tow trucks at any time while the tow truck is in motion.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
