DESCRIPTION

House Bill 1058 amends Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes to require courts to solicit and consider the opinions of potential kinship care resources in child custody proceedings.

The bill requires courts, during a child custody hearing, to allow those who wish to provide kinship care to be given notice of a hearing and the right to be heard regarding their qualifications to provide care.

This act shall take effect in 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
